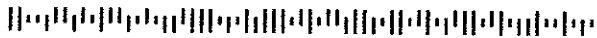

Beginning in April of 2017 our West Grand Blvd.-Sterling banking center will begin the process to relocate to another facility and we will be opening a temporary drive-thru location that will be located at the corner of Lincoln and West Grand Blvd at 2838 West Grand Blvd., Detroit, MI 48202 to serve our customers within the community. This location will include a 24 hour ATM and two Banker Connect remote teller units (open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. ET.), where customers can see and talk to a customer service representative, make deposits or withdrawals, cash checks and much more! Then during 2018, we will move into a brand new facility we are planning at Third & West Grand Blvd. that will provide extended banking hours and the conveniences you currently enjoy for our West Grand Blvd.-Sterling and Fisher Building customers.

Effective April 28, 2017 your account(s) will be moved from our West Grand Blvd.-Sterling banking center to our Fisher Building banking center located 3011 West Grand Blvd., Detroit, MI 48202, less than a mile from our current location. At that time you will be able to use our temporary drive-thru referenced above, our Fisher Building banking center or any of our banking centers that are convenient for you to visit to access your accounts.

No action is required on your part. You will continue to have the same account number(s)¹, so you do not need to order new checks or make any account changes. Our dedicated West Grand Blvd.-Sterling staff will be glad to answer any questions you may have. We will continue to offer full-service banking at the West Grand Blvd.-Sterling banking center until the close of business on April 28, 2017. Plus, you can continue to access your account(s) 24 hours a day, seven days a week when using your Comerica Debit Card, Comerica Web Banking® and Comerica Mobile Banking®.
